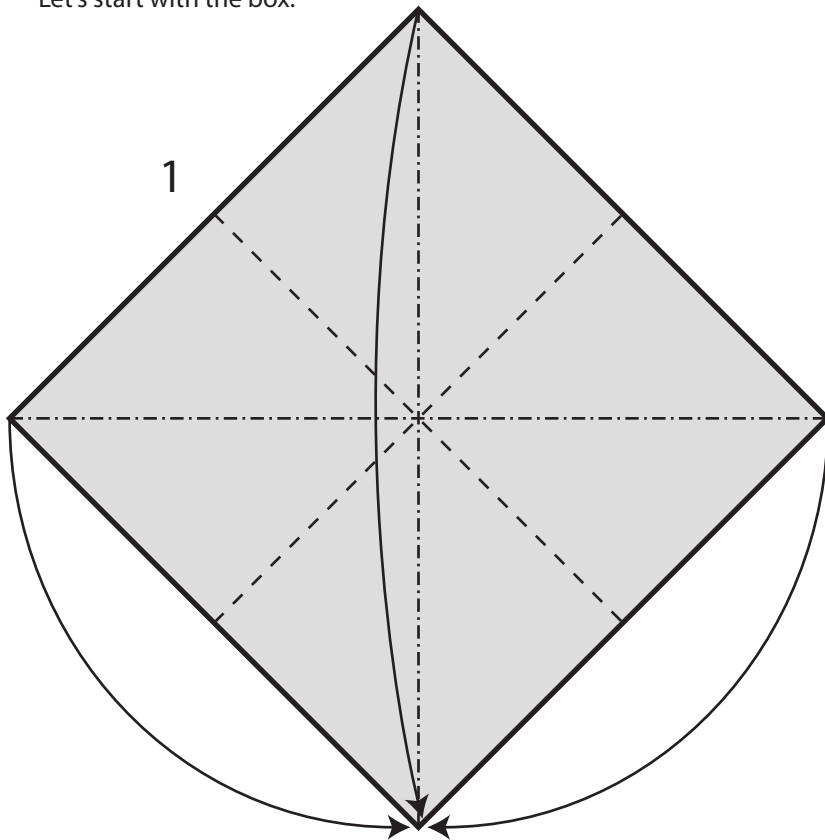


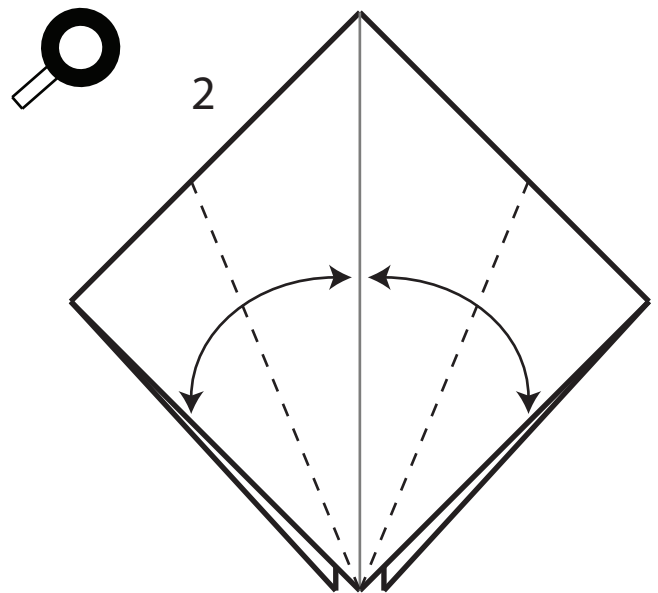
# Dreggy, the Babydragon-Egg-Box

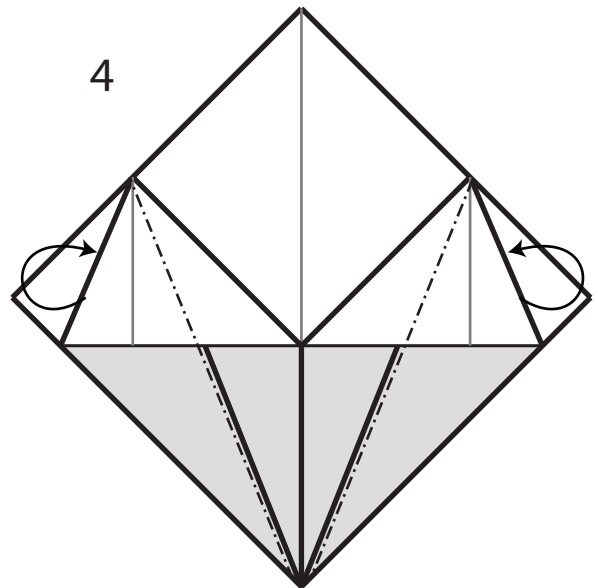
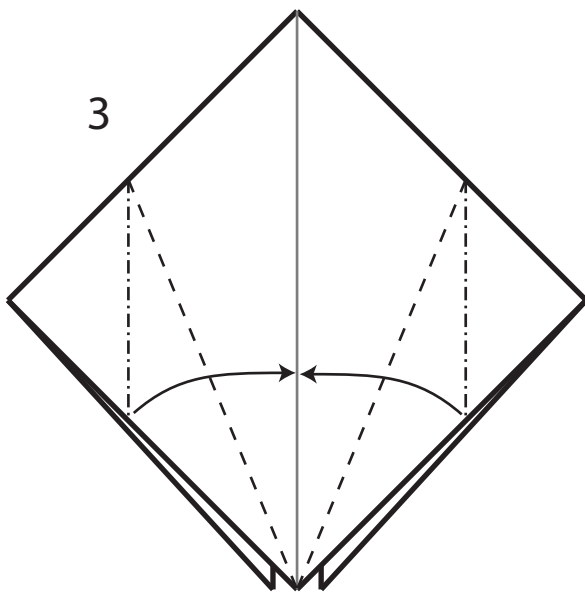
This diagram is for advanced Origami-folders. You need 2 identical sheets of square paper, colored on one side, white on the other. Let's start with the box:



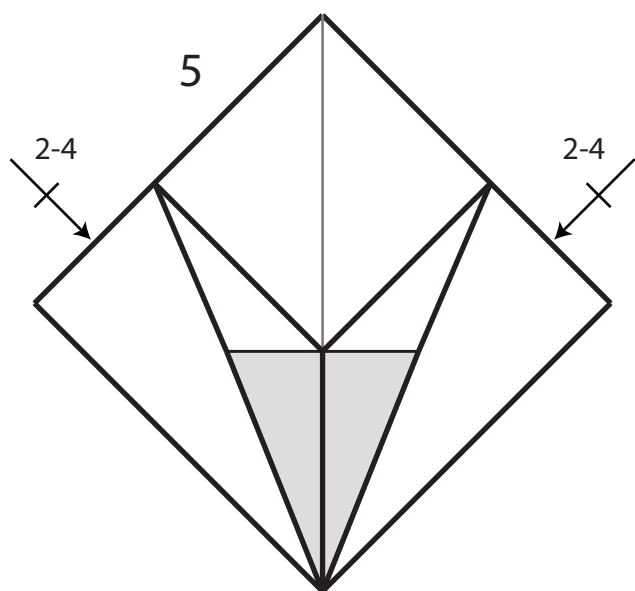
If you don't know what this means, you're not an advanced folder \*g\*



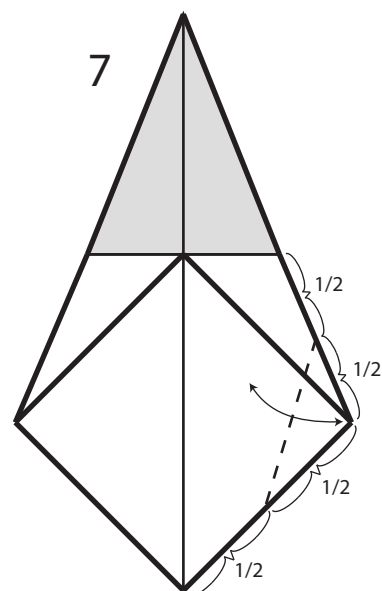
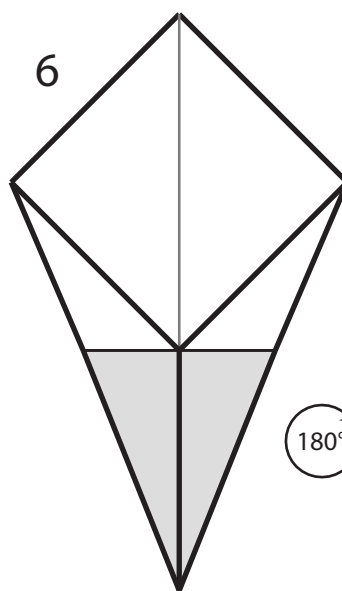
Fold and unfold.



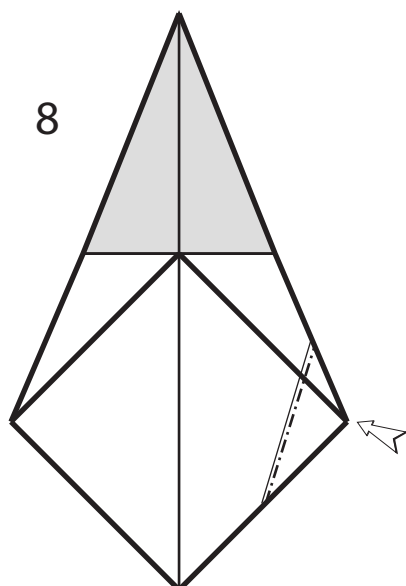
Fold inside



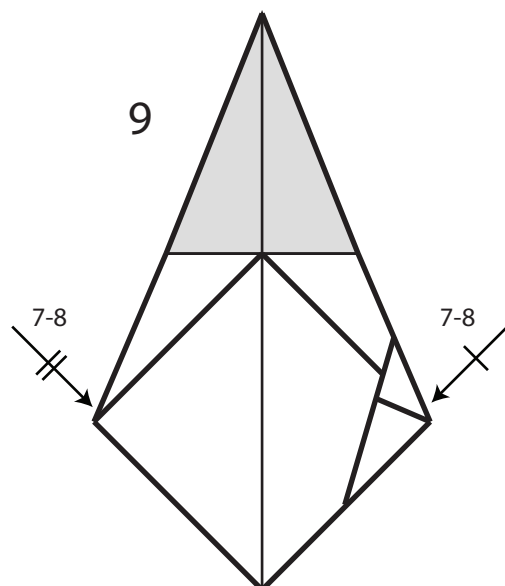
Repeat steps 2-4 on the flipside.



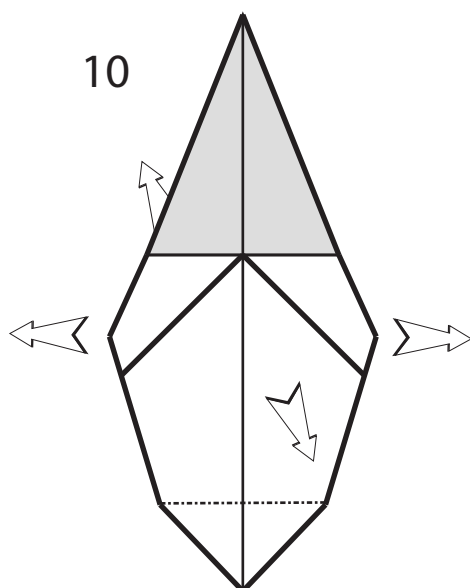
Prefold as shown



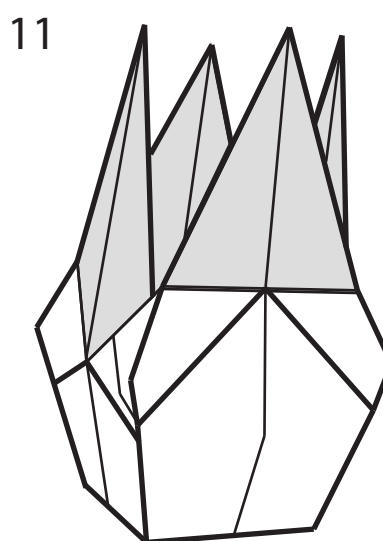
Sink the prefolded corner



Repeat step 7-8 on the other three corners.



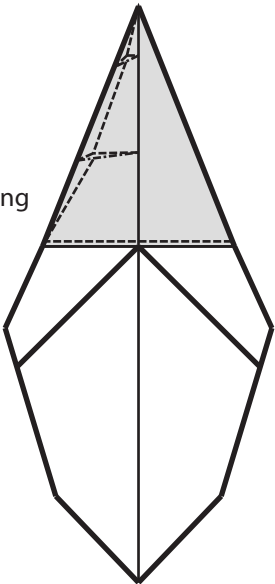
Pull the model open, forming a box...



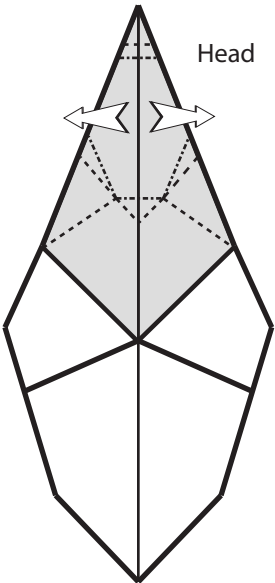
...like this

Ok, lets form the baby dragon.

Right wing

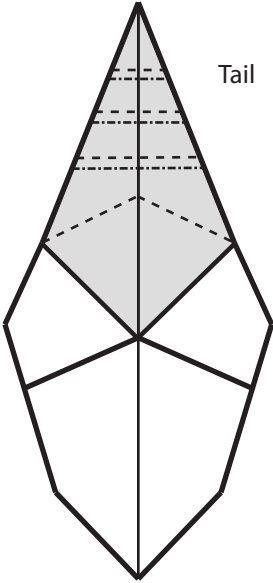


Head

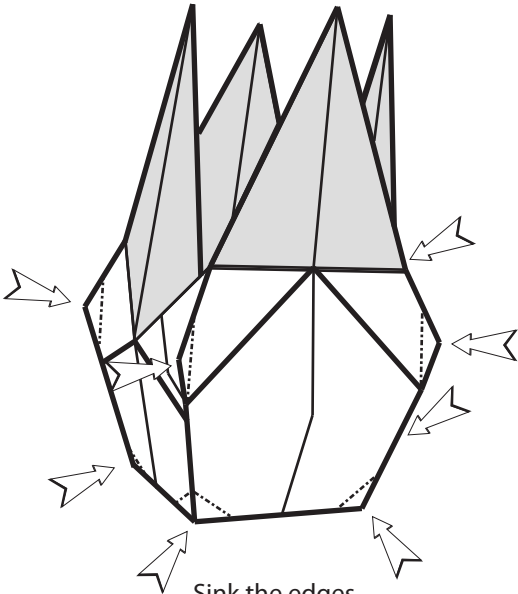


Form the head as shown, then fold up the top layers at 90°

Tail

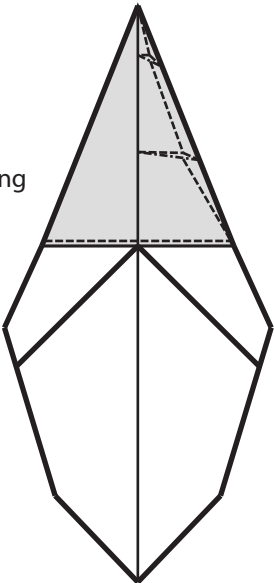


Harmonica-Fold the tail, then gently pull it out and down.

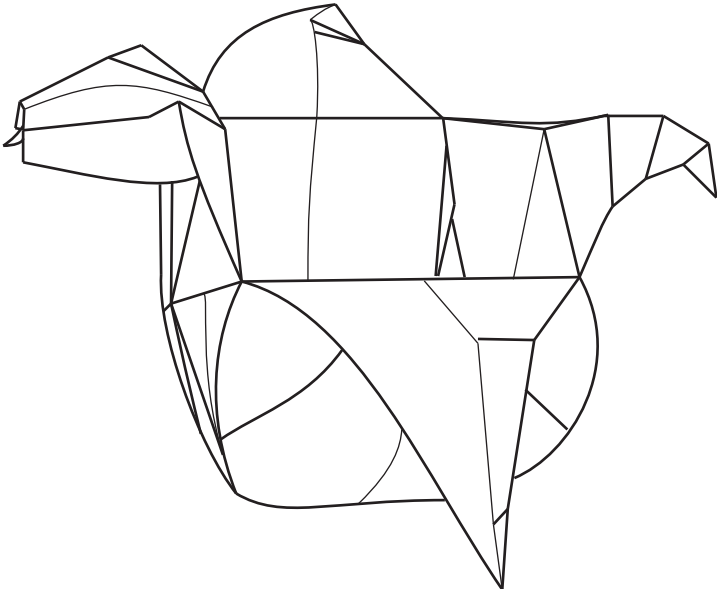


Sink the edges to form an egg-shape.

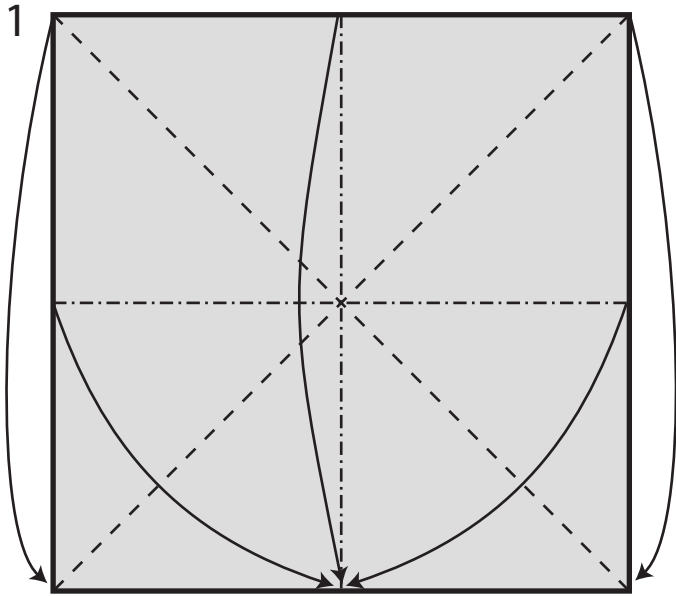
Left wing



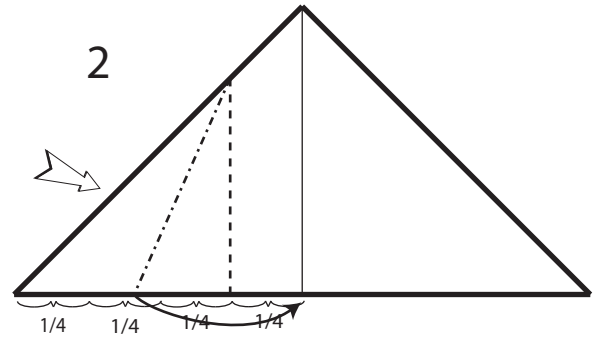
The final box. Now let's do the top.



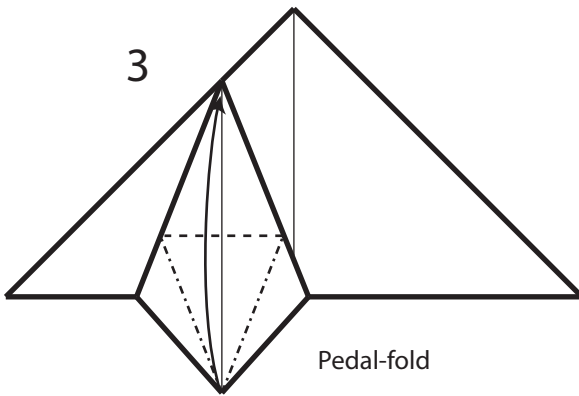
# Babydragon-Egg Top



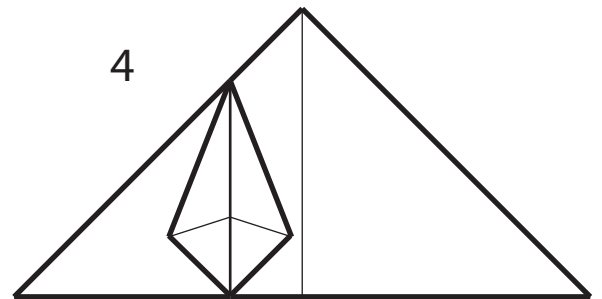
Waterbomb base.



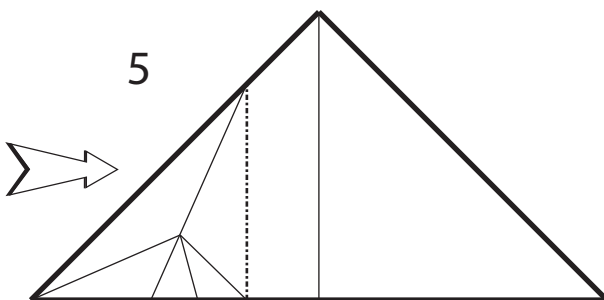
Squash fold at 3/4 of the left side.



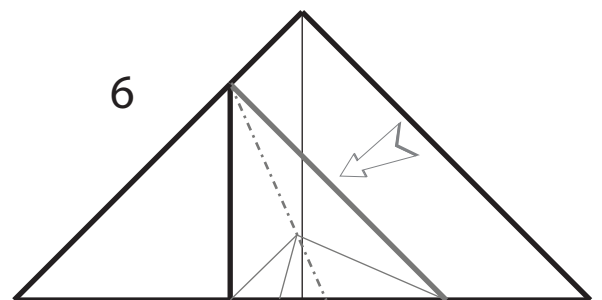
Pedal-fold



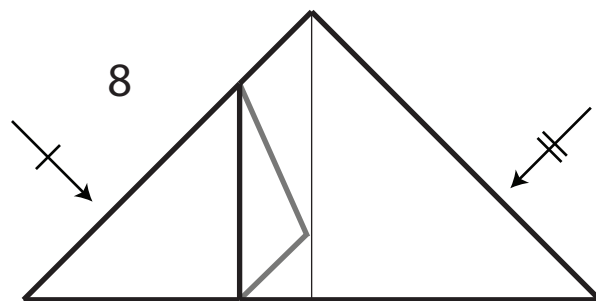
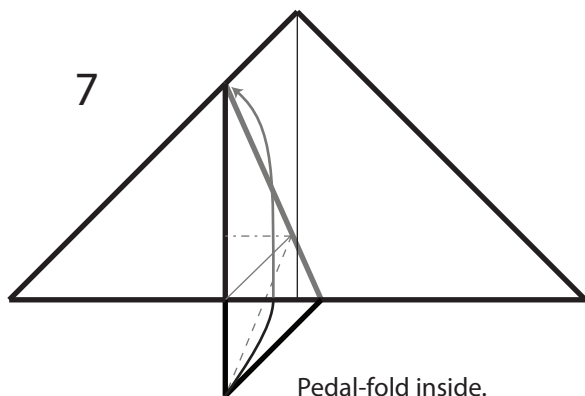
Unfold to step 2



We're now refolding step 2-3 in the inside.  
First, sink corner at the folding of step 2

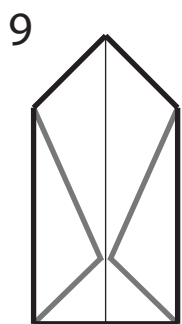


Sink again.

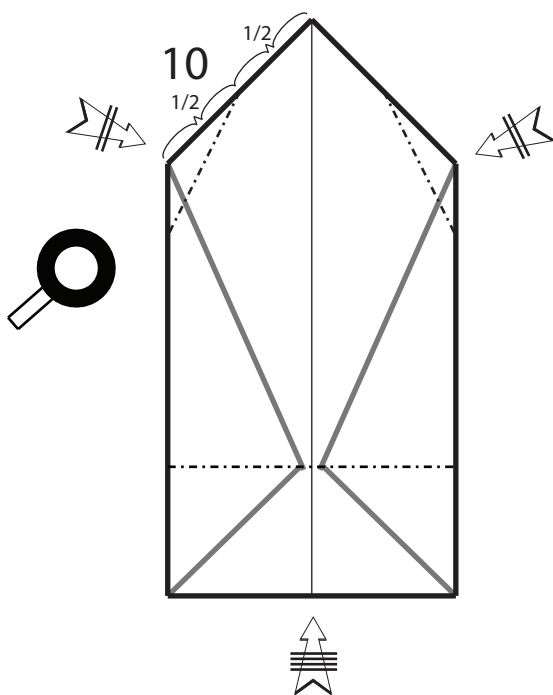


Repeat step 5-7 at the other 3 corners

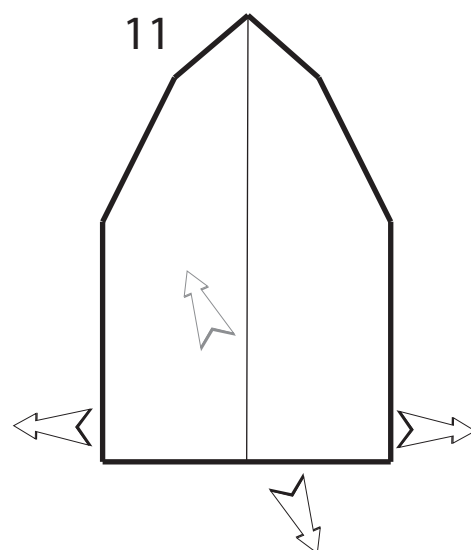
**Tipp:** To make things easier to fold, start with the colored side down, do step 2-4 on all 4 corners, unfold the model, refold the Waterbomb base with the colored side up, and then do step 5-8.



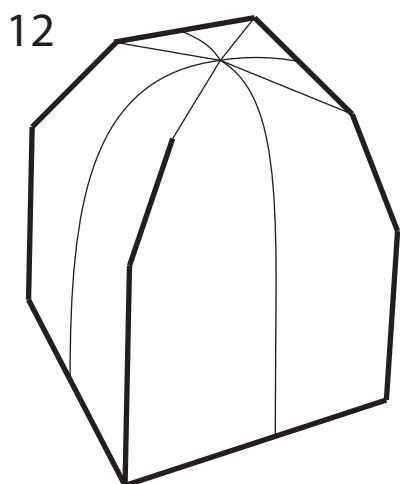
Lets take a closer look...



Sink all four top corners as shown.  
Fold all four bottom flaps inside as far as possible



Pull the model open like you did with the box earlier, forming the top...



...like this. Now, push the top inside of the box.
