



This diagram is for advanced Origami-folders. You need 2 identical sheets of square paper, colored on one side, white on the other. Let's start with the box:





If you don't know what this means, you're not an advanced folder \*g\*

Fold and unfold.










Repeat steps 2-4 on the flipside.



Sink the prefolded corner





Pull the model open, forming a box...


Prefold as shown




Repeat step 7-8 on the other three corners.












Waterbomb base.







Unfold to step 2




We're now refolding step 2-3 in the inside. First, sink corner at the folnding of step 2




Sink again.

**Tipp**: To make things easier to fold, start with the colored side down, do step 2-4 on all 4 corners, unfold the model, refold the Waterbomb base with the colored side up, and then do step 5-8.



Sink all four top corners as shown. Fold all four bottom flaps inside as far as possible

...like this. Now, push the top inside of the box.
