
For best effect, start with a 2-colored paper. White side up




Squash fold both sides.




Outside fold the two triangles




Squash fold








Petal fold. Those will be the eyes.




Turn around.









Repeat steps 9-13 on the other half




Fold top layer only







Squash fold along the cease lines from step 11

Let's zoom in bit. Fold up the top layer



Lets form the head! Rabbit ear fold the mouth, but don't flatten it. Reverse petal fold the eyes, lifting the triangles a bit. Mountain fold the top of the head.

Now, bend both outer bands behind, sticking one end into the other one.

The finished ring should look like this:
