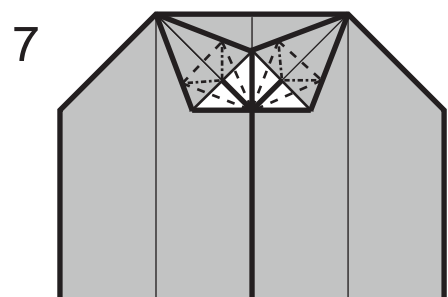
For best effect, start with a 2-colored paper. White side up



Outside fold the two triangles

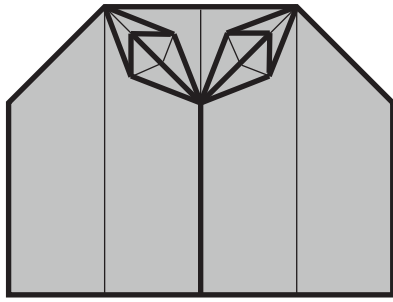


Squash fold



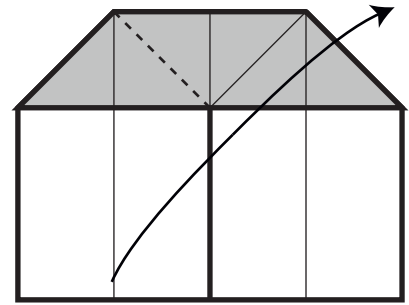
Petal fold. Those will be the eyes.

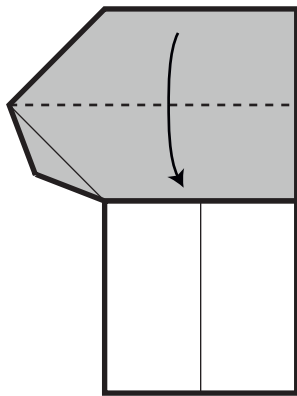
Turn around.

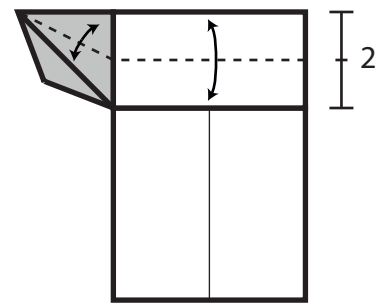


Fold top layer only

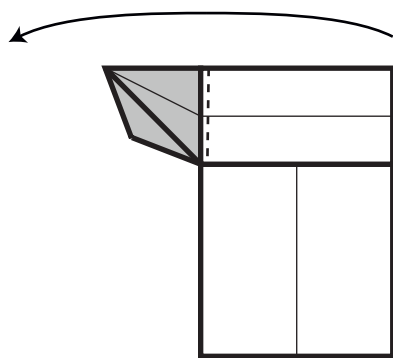

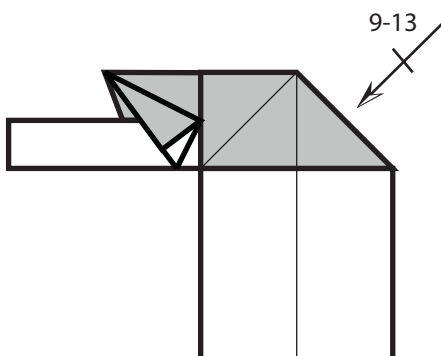

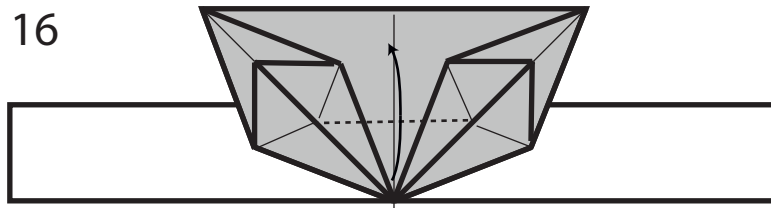
Repeat steps 9-13 on the other half

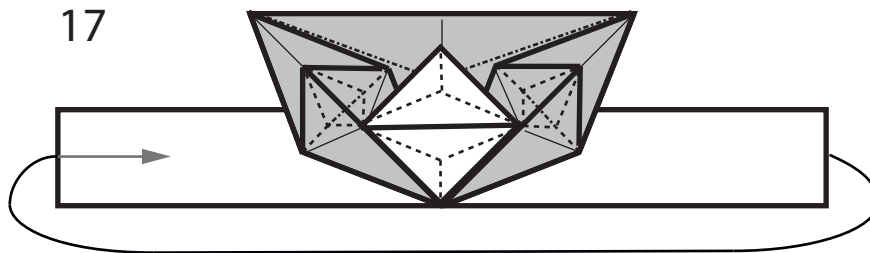

Reverse petal fold the eyes, lifting the triangles a bit.

Mountain fold the top of the head.

Now, bend both outer bands behind,
sticking one end into the other one.
